- 108: Fabricating Plate-Work (written test and practical assessment)

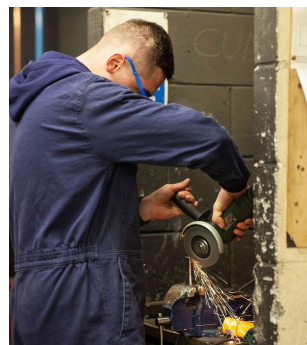
Next steps after this course:
