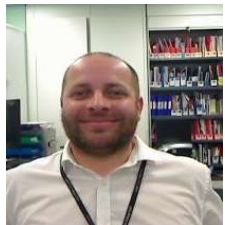

About this course

This programme is ideal for school leavers who want to become skilled crafts people. The course develops your structural knowledge and building skills. You will learn by a series of practical exercises in well-equipped workshops, backed up by relevant classroom theory. Students can choose to focus on one of two trade areas available: site carpentry and bench joinery.

Modules:

- Health and safety
- Constructing halving joints
- Constructing mortise and tenons
- Fitting locks and latches
- Fitting architraves and skirting boards

Equipment required

We recommend wearing overalls or work clothes that you don't mind getting dirty; along with protective footwear, like steel toe-capped boots. You will also need a pen, pencil, tape measure, folder, lined paper and a padlock for a locker.
