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About this course

The Level 2 Bricklaying course is designed to teach the more advanced hand skills needed to become a successful and qualified bricklayer. The course is designed to give the candidate a more in-depth analysis following the level 1 qualification. Throughout the level 2 course, candidates will participate in work experience - making them more employable and equipping them with key information on how building sites work.

Modules:

- Health and Safety in construction
- Building methods and construction technology
- Interpreting working drawings to set out masonry structures
- Thin joint masonry and masonry structures
- Constructing solid and cavity walling

Equipment required

We recommend wearing overalls or work clothes that you don't mind getting dirty; along with protective footwear, like steel toe-capped boots. You will also need a pen, pencil, tape measure, folder, lined paper and a padlock for a locker.
