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About this course

At this level, students are likely to have decided between site carpentry and bench joinery, and will be gaining workplace experience to develop skills and knowledge to increase their employability. Students will become skilled with a wide range of tools (including power tools) and will have a growing understanding of materials and the importance of housekeeping. Students will also take more responsibility for carrying out well-defined tasks, making choices about the methods that are appropriate and dealing with straightforward problems.

Modules:

- Carry out safe working practices in construction
- Information, quantities and communicating with others
- Building methods and construction technology
- Carry out first fixing operations
- Carry out second fixing - erect structural carcassing
- Carry out maintenance
- Set up and operate a circular saw
- Construct a timber frame entrance

Equipment Required

We recommend wearing overalls or work clothes that you don't mind getting dirty; along with protective footwear, like steel toe-capped boots. You will also need a pen, pencil, tape measure, folder, lined paper and a padlock for a locker.
