They work across a wide range of projects, from refurbishments and heritage restorations to large-scale commercial builds. As technical experts, they are responsible for setting out and laying bricks and blocks accurately to plans and specifications, ensuring high standards of quality and finish. They often take a leadership role on-site, planning work, supervising others, and providing advice on techniques and problem-solving. Craft bricklayers also prioritise health, safety, and environmental considerations, helping to promote sustainable construction practices across their teams.
