Choosing Your Pathway

Every learner's journey is different. We look at your GCSE results, interests, aspirations and previous experience before recommending the most suitable starting point for you.

English and maths

Some pathways may require you to have GCSE English and maths at grade 4 (previous grade C). If you don't have GCSE English and maths at grade 4, we'll build these into your study programme to help you achieve your goals.

We will always consider your personal circumstances. If you haven't quite got the grades you wanted, we'll help you find the best pathway for you.

Your starting point depends on your aspirations, previous learning and GCSE results.

Level 3

Typically four GCSEs at grades 9-3, including English and maths at minimum grade 4.

Progression to Level 4

Typically A Levels or Diploma/Access Level 3 qualification. NVQ Level 3 may be accepted in some cases.

Level 2

Usually three/four GCSEs at grade 9-3 including English and maths.

Level 1

Usually three/four GCSEs, including English and maths.

Entry

No formal entry requirements.

Depending on the outcome of your interview, you'll receive an offer to study with us. Offers are usually conditional on you achieving the relevant GCSE grades.

Enrolment

We'll contact you before enrolment with all the information you need to complete the process.

Pre-Supported Internship

This one-year course with a college work placement, works towards increasing confidence in those not yet ready for a Supported Internship. Job coaches mentor and support you to produce a portfolio, increase your confidence in the workplace and develop essential work skills.

Foundation Studies

Foundation Studies is a supportive provision for young adults who have, or are working towards, Entry Level 2 and have an EHCP. Our pathways reflect different stages of independence, ensuring all learners receive the right level of support.

All pathways include Maths, English, PSHCE, Personal Development, PE, Wellbeing and Digital Skills. Learners are placed within our pathways based not only on their academic level, but also on their social, emotional and communication needs.

- **Develop skills through practical classes**
- **Gain work experience in the Pit Stop Shop**
- **Make use of our classroom kitchen**

Living and Learning

For learners working towards Entry Level 3, this pathway is designed for developing independence with moderate support. To enhance learning engagement, we provide community activities and tailored guidance.

Independent Living

This pathway is for learners who have, or are working towards, Entry Level 2 and need structured guidance to develop independence in daily living, functional literacy and numeracy, and practical skills. This is a hands-on pathway, providing the skills needed for greater independence and personal development.

Living and Working

Learners working towards Entry Level 3 or Level 1 who demonstrate greater independence and can engage in learning, work-related activities and preparation for employment with minimal support.

Learners may move between pathways or into placements within mainstream courses as they progress, depending on their individual needs. All placement and progression decisions are made on a personalised basis, supporting each learner to build confidence, independence, and skills for life and work.
